YOUR ITINERARY

DAY 1: OCTOBER 9

ARRIVE IN NAIROBI, KENYA

JAMBO – KARIBU!! It is 'touch down' at the Jomo Kenyatta International Airport. Representatives of African Travel, Inc., eagerly await your arrival in traditional African style – wet towels and bubbly. Thereafter transfer to your hotel in Nairobi, Kenya's colourful capital city to check in to your city hotel. Rest of the day or evening is spent at leisure.

DAY 2: OCTOBER 10

NAIROBI

Begin your day with breakfast at the hotel before setting out to explore the vibrant city of Nairobi. Today offers a thoughtfully curated blend of wildlife conservation, cultural experiences, and local craftsmanship. Start with a visit to the renowned Sheldrick Wildlife Trust, where you'll meet rescued elephants and learn about ongoing conservation efforts. Continue to the Giraffe Centre for a memorable up-close encounter with endangered Rothschild giraffes. Next, visit Kobe Tough Beads Women's Cooperative, where you'll see local artisans at work and browse handcrafted ceramics and jewelry. Enjoy lunch at the Karen Blixen Coffee Garden & Cottages (set menu), set within lush gardens steeped in history. Return to your hotel for a leisurely afternoon. This evening, gather for a welcome cocktail to toast the start of your journey. (BL)

DAY 3: OCTOBER 11

NAIROBI / SAMBURU GAME RESERVE

After breakfast, depart north via Nanyuki to Samburu National Reserve, a rugged and scenic semi-arid wilderness. Arrive in time for lunch, followed by a short siesta before heading out on an afternoon game drive. The Ewaso Nyiro River winds through the reserve, attracting abundant wildlife including large herds of elephants. Samburu is also home to unique northern species such as the gerenuk, Grevy's zebra, reticulated giraffe, and Somali ostrich, along with prolific birdlife. As the day ends, take in the striking beauty of a red sunset over the doum palms along the river—a perfect close to your safari. Enjoy dinner and overnight at camp. (BL)

DAY 4: OCTOBER 12

SAMBURU GAME RESERVE

Start your day with a memorable bubbly bush breakfast in the wild, paired with morning game viewing across Samburu National Reserve and Buffalo Springs National Reserve. Return to camp to relax before heading out on an afternoon



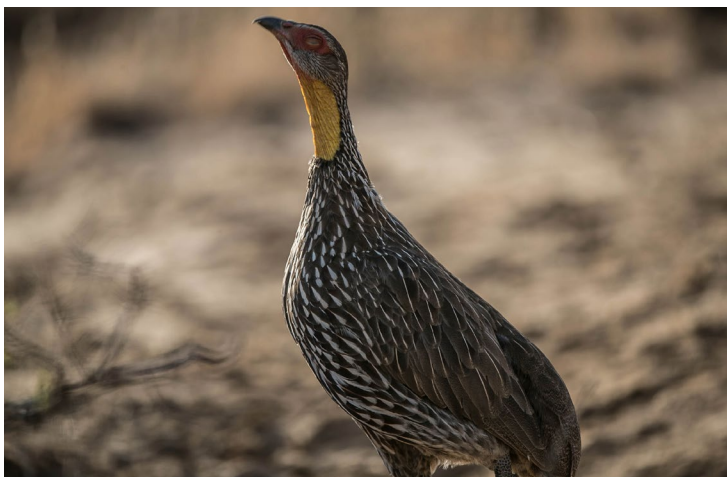
game drive. Later, visit a local Samburu manyatta for insight into the traditions and daily life of the Samburu people, whose culture shares close ties with the Maasai. (BLD)

DAY 5: OCTOBER 13
SAMBURU / LAKE NAKURU

After breakfast, depart for Lake Nakuru National Park, stopping en route at Thomson's Falls for a breathtaking view. Arrive in time for lunch before heading out on an afternoon game drive. The environment here is welcoming, one of the best places to relax, to unwind, to enjoy nature's beauty. Explore this scenic park, known for highlights such as Baboon Cliff, Lion Hill, and the Mau Escarpment. Spot a variety of wildlife including lion, buffalo, Rothschild giraffe, zebra, and both black and white rhino, along with abundant birdlife. As the day winds down, enjoy a bush sundowner with canapés in a picturesque setting. Return to your lodge for dinner and overnight. (BLD)

DAY 6: OCTOBER 14

LAKE NAKURU

Enjoy a full day of morning and afternoon game drives in Lake Nakuru National Park, renowned for its incredible



birdlife, including vibrant flocks of flamingos. The lake's algae-rich waters attract pelicans, spoonbills, and storks, creating a spectacular wildlife scene. Set along the Rift Valley escarpment, the park offers stunning viewpoints such as Makalia Falls and Baboon Cliff. Wildlife sightings often include black and white rhino, giraffe, zebra, waterbuck, and predators such as lion, cheetah, leopard, and hyena. (BLD)

DAY 7: OCTOBER 15
LAKE NAKURU / MAASAI MARA

After an early breakfast, journey to the iconic Maasai Mara National Reserve, enjoying scenic landscapes and wildlife along the way. Arrive at your tented camp in time for lunch, followed by a short rest before heading out on an afternoon game drive. Explore the Mara's vast rolling plains, home to an abundance of wildlife including lion, elephant, buffalo, wildebeest, zebra, giraffe, and predators such as leopard, cheetah, and hyena. Renowned for its rich biodiversity, the



reserve offers exceptional game viewing. Return to camp for a cocktail with appetizers, followed by dinner. (BLD)

DAY 8: OCTOBER 16
MAASAI MARA

Begin your day with a magical early morning balloon safari over the sweeping plains (additional cost). Drift silently above the wildlife below, enjoying a unique bird's-eye perspective as the natural drama of the savanna unfolds. Guided by gentle jets of hot air, your balloon glides for approximately 45 minutes, accompanied by a team of ground vehicles. After a smooth landing, celebrate with a glass of chilled sparkling wine and a full English breakfast. Conclude the experience with a leisurely game drive back to the lodge. The Maasai Mara is one of Africa's greatest wildlife reserves and animal viewing is spectacular year-round. You may see a pride of lions stalking their prey, observe a herd of elephant and their fascinating social structure, or see pods of hippo wallowing in the rivers. Tonight enjoy a memorable bush dinner under the stars. Set in a secluded outdoor location, the evening features a beautifully prepared meal surrounded by the sights and sounds of the African wilderness—an unforgettable and intimate safari experience. (BLD)

DAY 9: OCTOBER 17
MAASAI MARA

Enjoy another day of morning and afternoon game drives in the iconic Masai Mara. Explore vast golden savannas, winding rivers, and acacia-dotted plains in search of Africa's most iconic wildlife. Spot lions lounging in the shade, cheetahs on the hunt, herds of elephants, and towering giraffes, while observing the intricate balance of predator and prey in their natural habitat. (BLD)

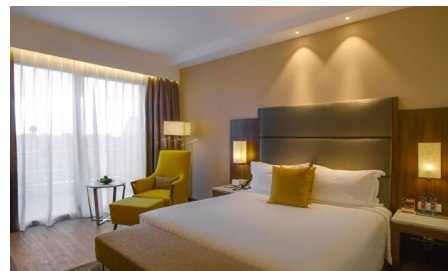
SAROVA LION HILL GAME LODGE 2 Nights
